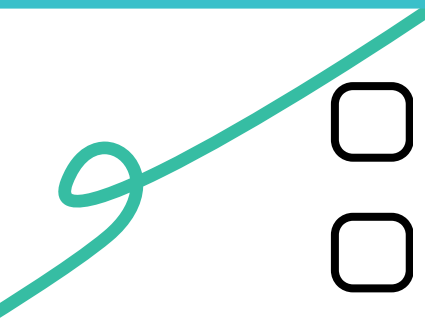


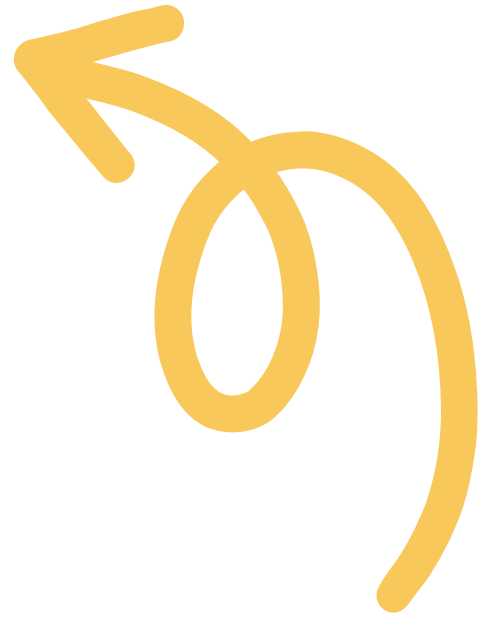

Supplies and Preparation List

- Make 15 things wacky around the house - upside down, backwards, inspiration from the book, etc. - all things the kids can find for the scavenger hunt

Instructions

- Rainbow breakfast: Make fruity pebble french toast (recipe below)
- Wacky dress up: Everybody dress up wacky - backwards, mismatched, crazy hair, etc.
- Read Wacky Wednesday
- Silly Scavenger Hunt: Use the scavenger hunt printout and find all the wacky things around the house
- Kooky Crafts: oobleck, wacky sacks, one fish two fish alphabet matching, popcorn plates, silly self portrait (see instructions below)
- Loopy Lunch: Inside-out sandwiches or grilled cheese roll ups. (recipe below) And eat under the table!
- Watch Cat in the Hat: on Peacock
- Mad about Madlibs: Fill out the madlibs together
- Wild with Water: Create a water station to explore and play - add different colors of water and different tools to make it interesting (droppers, measuring cups, spoons, cups, different sized bins etc. Depending on the weather this can be an indoor or outdoor activity. Water beads should be outside.



- Silly Supper: Chicken nugget charcuterie (or another type with dessert included on the board!)
- Bonus: Sleep upside down tonight! Turn the beds around to make everything topsy turvy.



Fruity Pebble French Toast

3 large eggs
1 tsp vanilla
2 cups fruity pebbles
Whipped cream

1 cup milk
8 slices bread
4 Tbsp butter



1. In a shallow dish, whisk together eggs, milk, vanilla, and cinnamon until combined. Working one slice at a time, dip bread until fully soaked, 45 seconds.
2. In a separate bowl, add Fruity Pebbles. Transfer soaked bread to Fruity Pebbles and press to coat. (Use your hands if necessary.)
3. In a large skillet over medium-low heat, melt 2 tablespoons butter. Add French toast and cook 3 minutes per side. Repeat with remaining butter and slices.
4. Serve with whipped cream.

Grilled Cheese Roll Ups

6 slices of bread
1 cup shredded cheese or
american cheese slices

2 Tbsp butter
6 slices of ham or turkey
(optional)

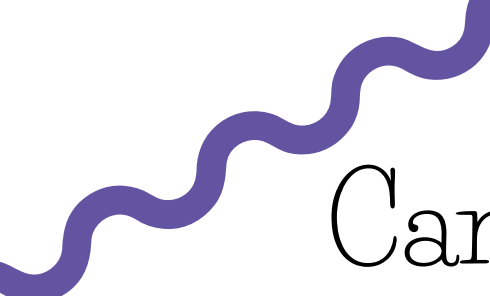


1. Trim the crust off the bread.
2. Roll the bread flat.
3. Add the cheese. You can add ham too if you like.
4. Roll it up tightly. Use toothpicks if necessary to hold it together.
5. Heat skillet to between medium and medium-low. Add the butter. Then place the grilled cheese roll-ups in the pan.
6. Cook for 5 to 8 minutes, turning them periodically with tongs so they brown evenly.
7. Remove and cut in half if you like. Serve!

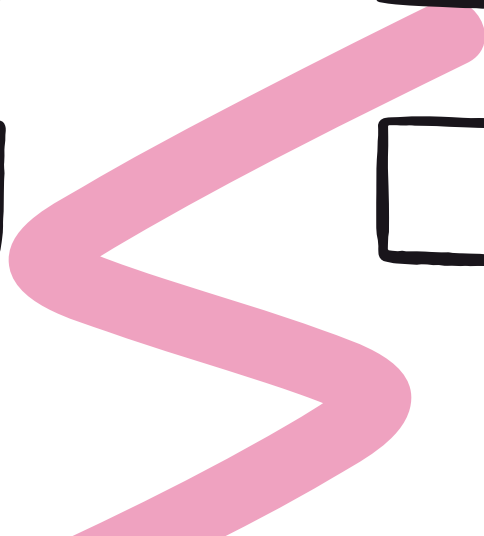
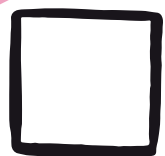
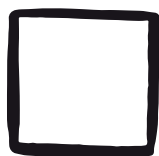
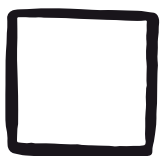
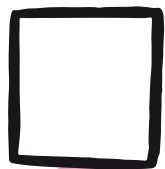
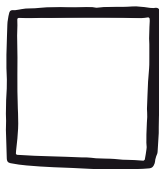
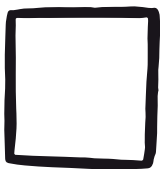
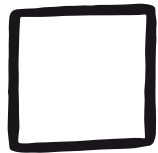
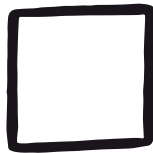
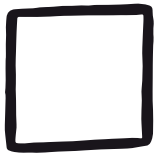
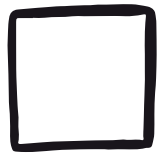
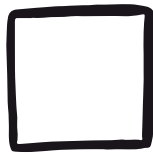
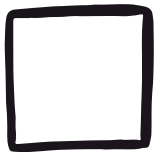
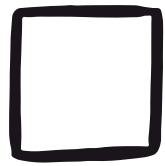
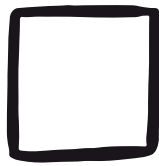
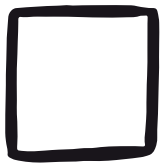
Chicken Nugget Charcuterie / Charcuterie Ideas

Oobleck

1. Measure $\frac{3}{4}$ cup of water in a measuring cup.
2. If you have food coloring, add a couple of drops to the water.
3. Measure 1 cup of cornstarch into a separate bowl.
4. Add the water and food coloring.
5. Mix the mixture. It will take about 10 minutes to be evenly mixed and you may need to add more water and/or cornstarch to get the consistency just right.



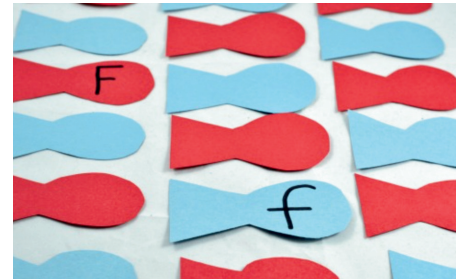
Wacky Sacks

1. Roll out your play dough into a long thin line. (I use one tub of dough per balloon)
2. Stretch your balloon as wide as you can and stuff the play dough inside. (Adults can do this themselves, but kids will need help with this part.)
3. Press the filled balloon to make it flat and get as much air out as possible. Tie it off with a knot.
4. Add a face using your sharpie and you're finished!



One Fish Two Fish Alphabet Matching

1. Cut out red and blue fish (template for fish included)
2. Write uppercase letters on the red set of fish
3. Write lowercase letters on the blue set of fish
4. Flip them over and match!



Popcorn Plates

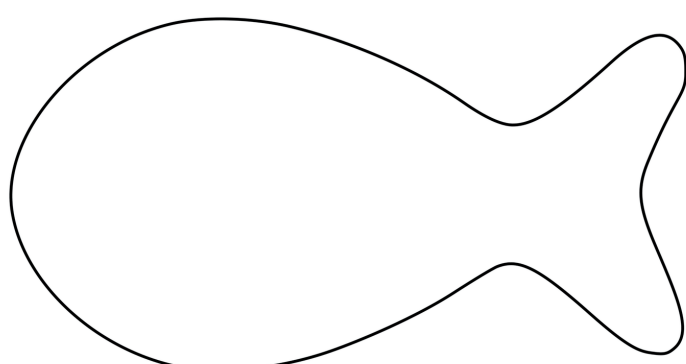
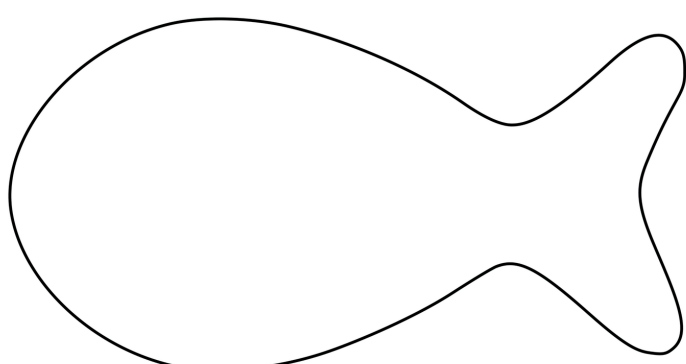
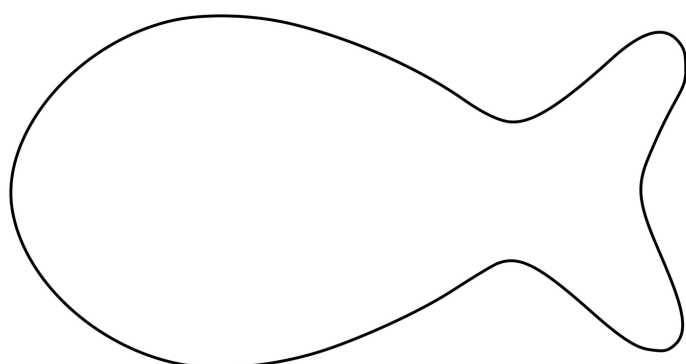
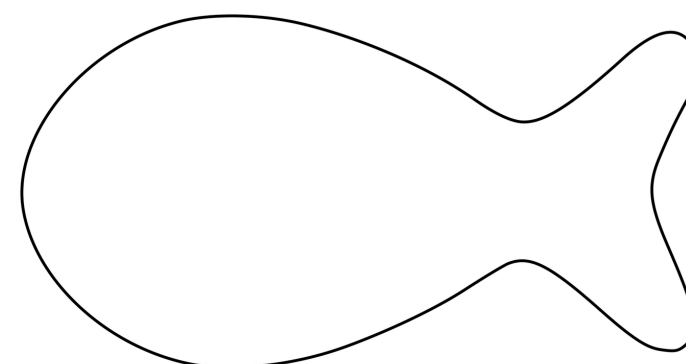
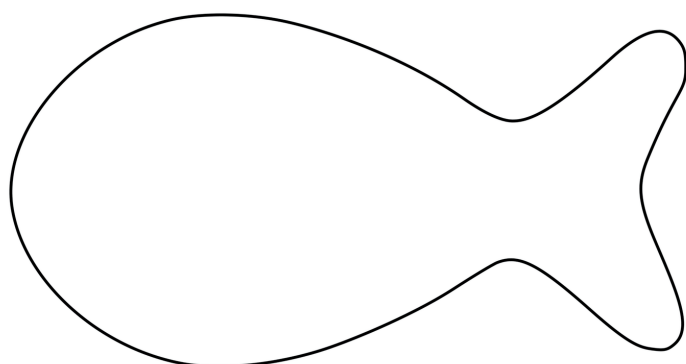
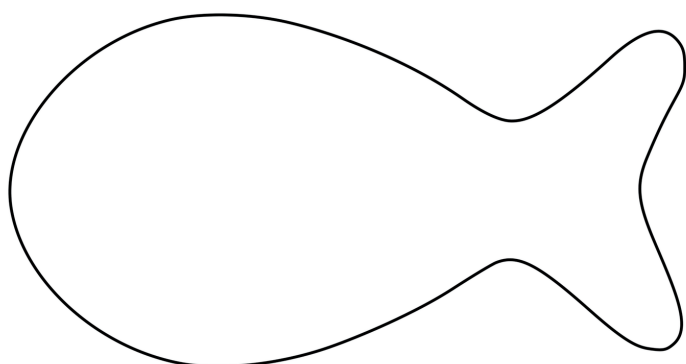
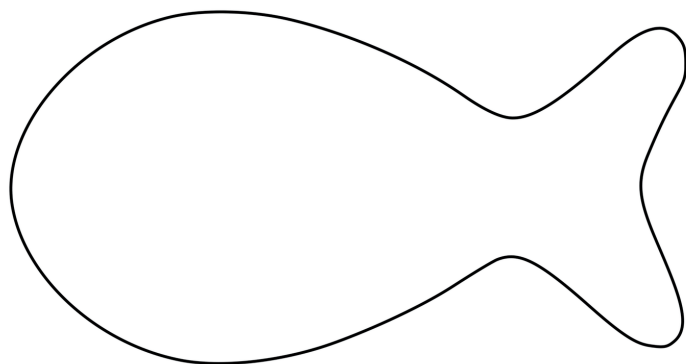
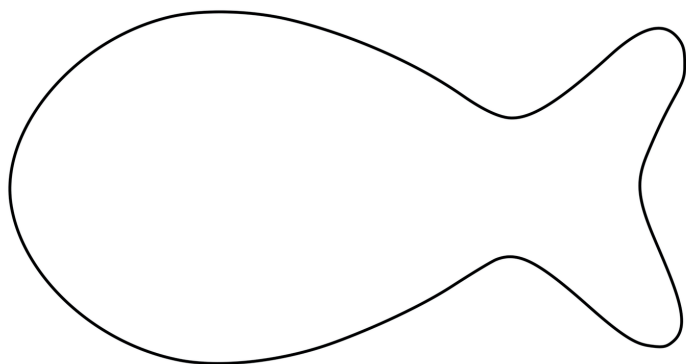
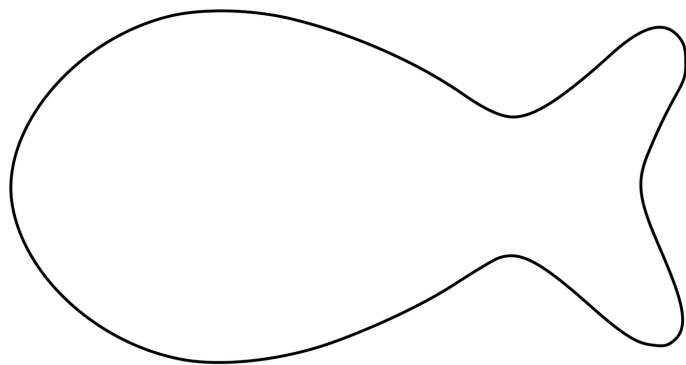
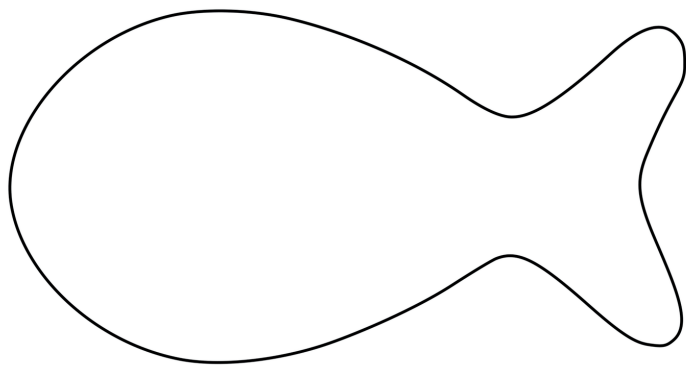
1. Pop some popcorn

4. Glue on mouths, googly eyes, and popcorn to make a silly face

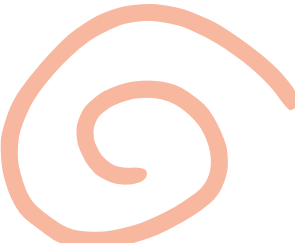


Silly Self Portrait

3. Fold or curl the construction paper strips to make silly hair for the self portrait







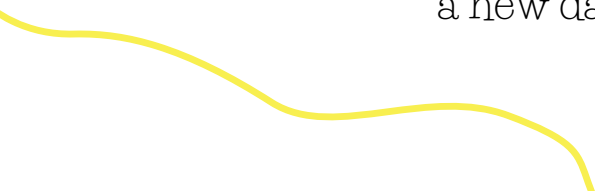
